Neeraj Chopra Clinches Silver in Javelin at Paris 2024 Olympics

Neeraj Chopra, the reigning Olympic champion, put on an impressive display at the Paris Olympics, winning the silver medal in the men's javelin throw event. Chopra's season-best throw of **89.45m** earned him the runner-up position, but he was unable to defend his title, as Pakistan's Arshad Nadeem broke the **Olympic record** with a stunning throw of **92.97m**.

Chopra, who was the defending champion coming into the competition, was unable to replicate his gold-medal-winning performance from the 2020 Tokyo Olympics. However, his silver-medal finish is still a remarkable achievement, as he continues to establish himself as one of the world's premier javelin throwers.

Arshad Nadeem's Historic Gold Medal

This new award system, replacing over 300 previous awards from various science departments, aims to celebrate the achievements of academics, technologists, and inventors across the country.

The Vigyan Ratna Puraskar: Honoring a Lifetime of Achievement

Dr. Govindarajan Padmanabhan: The First Recipient

The highest honor, the **Vigyan Ratna Puraskar**, has been awarded to **Dr. Govindarajan Padmanabhan**, a celebrated biochemist and former director of the Indian Institute of Science-Bengaluru. Dr. Padmanabhan, also a Padma Bhushan laureate, receives this lifetime achievement award in recognition of his significant contributions to the field of biochemistry.

Categories and Recipients

The government announced a total of 33 Rashtriya Vigyan Puraskars across various categories:

Vigyan Shri Awards

Thirteen scientists received the Vigyan Shri award for their distinguished contributions across different scientific domains.

Vigyan Yuva-Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Awards

Eighteen young scientists under the age of 45 were honored with the Vigyan Yuva-Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar awards, continuing the legacy of the prestigious Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar prize.

Vigyan Team Award

The **Team Chandrayaan-3** was recognized with the **Vigyan Team** award for their exceptional contribution to India's space program, particularly for the successful moon landing mission.

Award Ceremony and Significance

National Space Day Celebration

President Droupadi Murmu is expected to present these awards on **August 23**, designated as **National Space Day** to commemorate the landing of Chandrayaan-3 near the Moon's South Pole.

Consolidation of Science Awards

This new award system represents a significant consolidation of India's science honors. It replaces the previous system, which included the Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar award, instituted in 1958 and named after the renowned chemist who was the first chairman of the University Grants Commission and the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research.

Top 10 Richest Global Central Banks in 2024

A striking observation in the 2024 rankings is the dominance of European central banks. Seven out of the top ten central banks are based in Europe, with a combined worth of an astounding **\$11.09 trillion**. This underscores the economic strength and financial stability of the European region.

African Absence

Notably absent from the top 10 list are African central banks. This absence can be attributed to several challenges facing the region, including:

- . Rising inflation
- 2. Fragile financial markets
- 3. Weak monetary policy transmission systems

These factors highlight the economic disparities and developmental challenges that persist in certain regions.

India's Position

While not in the top 10, India's **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** holds a respectable 12th position globally. As of March 31, 2024, the RBI's balance sheet grew by **11.08%** year-on-year, reaching **Rs 70.47 trillion**. This growth is primarily attributed to the bank's liquidity management and foreign currency (forex) activities, reflecting India's growing economic influence on the global stage.

About National Film Awards



History of this award

The awards for actors and technicians working on the films were first given in 1967. **Nargis** was the first actor to win **Best Actress** for her performance in **Raat Aur Din.** Uttam Kumar won the Best Actor award for Antony Firingee and Chiriyakhana in the same year. Joint India-Ukraine statement

PM Modi's office in the joint **India-Ukraine statement** said both leaders reiterated their readiness for further cooperation in upholding principles of international law, including the UN Charter, such as respect for territorial integrity and sovereignty of states. "They agreed on the desirability of closer bilateral dialogue in this regard," the joint statement said.

India is not neutral

"We (India) are not neutral. From the very beginning, we have taken sides. And we have chosen the side of peace. We have come from the land of Buddha where there is no place for war," PM Modi said in his opening remarks during the talks. "We have come from the land of Mahatma Gandhi who had given a message of peace to the entire world," he said.

Expansion and deepen bilateral trade

Both sides agreed to ask the Indian-Ukrainian Intergovernmental Commission (IGC) to explore all possible ways to not only restore bilateral trade and economic relations to pre-conflict levels, but expand and deepen them further. There has been a significant reduction in the annual bilateral trade in goods since 2022 due to the challenges related to the ongoing conflict.

Diplomatic balancing act

PM Modi's visit to Kyiv is seen in many quarters as a diplomatic balancing act as his trip to Russia triggered anguish among some Western countries. External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar said PM Modi reiterated the need for "practical engagement" between all stakeholders to develop an innovative solution that will help build broad acceptability and contribute towards peace and stability.

Comprehensive reform of the UN Security Council

Both sides called for a comprehensive reform of the UN Security Council to reflect **contemporary global realities** and to make it more representative, effective and efficient in dealing with issues of **international peace and security.** Ukraine reiterated its support for **India's permanent membership** of a reformed and expanded **UN Security Council.**

Gol Approves Unified Pension Scheme for Government Employees

In a significant move to enhance retirement benefits for government employees, the Union Cabinet on Saturday approved the **Unified Pension Scheme (UPS)**. This new scheme is set to benefit approximately **23 lakh government employees** and will serve as an alternative to the existing National Pension System (NPS).

Background

The decision comes after a thorough review of the current pension system. In 2023, the finance ministry established a committee led by finance secretary TV Somanathan to evaluate the National Pension System for government employees. The NPS, which has been in effect since April 1, 2004, will now coexist with the newly introduced UPS.

Key Features of the Unified Pension Scheme

Assured Pension

One of the most notable features of the UPS is the **assured pension**. Employees who have completed a minimum qualifying service of 25 years will be entitled to a pension that is **50% of the average basic pay** drawn over the last 12 months prior to superannuation. This provision ensures a stable and substantial income for retirees.

For those with shorter service periods, a proportionate plan has been put in place. Employees with a minimum of 10 years of service will also be eligible for pension benefits, albeit at a reduced rate commensurate with their years of service.

Family Pension

The UPS also introduces an **assured family pension**. In the unfortunate event of an employee's death, their family will receive a pension at the rate of **60% of the employee's pension**. This provision offers crucial financial support to the families of deceased government employees.

Minimum Pension Guarantee

To ensure a basic standard of living for all retirees, the UPS establishes a **minimum pension of Rs. 10,000 per month**. This benefit is available to employees who have completed a minimum of 10 years of service and have reached superannuation.

Inflation Protection

Recognizing the impact of rising costs on retirees, the UPS includes provisions for **inflation indexation**. This feature applies to the assured pension, assured family pension, and the minimum pension. Additionally, **Dearness Relief** will be provided based on the All India Consumer Price Index for Industrial Workers (AICPI-IW), similar to the benefit extended to current service employees.



Lump Sum Payment

Upon superannuation, employees will receive a **lump sum payment** in addition to their gratuity. This payment will be calculated as **1/10th of the monthly emoluments** (pay plus Dearness Allowance) as on the date of superannuation for every completed six months of service. Importantly, this lump sum payment will not reduce the quantum of the assured pension.

Eligibility and Implementation

The Unified Pension Scheme is set to take effect from **April 1, 2025**. However, its benefits will extend retroactively to those who have already retired or will retire up until March 31, 2025, with arrears being provided.

Information and Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw highlighted that the scheme will positively impact approximately **23 lakh government employees**.

Transition from NPS to UPS

Current subscribers to the National Pension System will have the option to **switch to the UPS** from the next financial year. This flexibility allows employees to choose the scheme that best suits their retirement planning needs.

Paralympic Games Begin

French President Emmanuel Macron declared the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games open on Wednesday evening at Place de la Concorde. This is the first time that France has hosted the Paralympic Summer Games, and is also the first time that a Paralympics opening ceremony has taken place outside a stadium, in the heart of the host city.

Aim of this ceremony

"The aim of this ceremony is **to change the way we look** at **people with disabilities**, and to oppose all preconceived opinions on these issues, but not in a vain and sterile opposition," said Thomas Jolly, artistic director of the Paris 2024 ceremonies.

Participatory athletes

Around **4,400** athletes from a record 168 delegations will participate in the **11-day competition across 22 sports** starting from August 30, with **Eritrea**, **Kiribati** and **Kosovo** making their **Paralympic debuts**.

China's delegation

China's delegation entered with wheelchair fencer **Gu Haiyan** and weightlifter **Qi Yongkai** carrying the flag together. China has sent a delegation of **284 athletes** – **126 males and 158 females** – to compete across **302 events in 19 sports.** Among them, 95 are first-time Paralympians.

India's Participation in the 2024 Paralympics

India has been steadily increasing its presence in the Paralympic Games, and the 2024 edition is no exception. The Indian contingent comprises over **60 athletes** competing in a diverse range of sports, including athletics, powerlifting, shooting,

archery, badminton, and table tennis. This year, there is a special focus on athletics and badminton, where Indian athletes have shown considerable promise.

84 athletes for the Paris 2024 Paralympics, from India

India has announced a contingent of **84** athletes for the Paris **2024** Paralympics, marking the largest delegation the country has ever sent to the event. Scheduled to take place from **August 28 to September 8**, this year's team includes **32 women**, a significant increase from the **14 women** who participated in the **Tokyo 2020** Paralympics, where India sent a **total of 54 athletes**.

Participation from India in three new sports

For the first time, India will compete in **three new sports: paracycling**, **para-rowing**, and blind judo, expanding its participation to a total of 12 sports. In total, the **Paris 2024 Paralympics** will feature 22 sports.


