Centre Notifies Appointment Of Chief Justices Of 8 High Courts

The Central Government, through the Ministry of Law and Justice, notified the appointment of Chief Justices to eight High Courts to fill key judicial positions and ensure the smooth functioning of the judicial system in various states. Union Law (Independent Charge) **Arjun** announced the appointment of Chief Justices to eight High Courts.

Background

The Supreme Court Collegium, in its recommendations regarding the appointment of Chief Justices, originally made proposals on July 11, 2023. However, on September 17, 2023, the Collegium altered some of its earlier recommendations concerning the appointment of Chief Justices to four High Courts.

Global Innovation Index 2024

India has climbed to the 39th position among 133 global economies in the Global Innovation Index (GII) 2024, as announced by Union Minister Piyush Goyal. India also ranked 1st among 10 economies in the Central and Southern Asian region and led the lower-middle-income economies group. The country was 81st in 2015 and rose to 39th due to its thriving innovation ecosystem, powered by entrepreneurs, startups, and public-private partnerships.

Key Achievements

India ranked 1st in Central & Southern Asia and among lowermiddle-income economies, 4th in WIPO's Science & Technology Cluster Rankings, with cities like Mumbai, Delhi, Bengaluru, and Chennai in the global top 100 S&T clusters. India also ranked 7th globally in intangible asset intensity.

Global Performance Overview


"In Central and Southern Asia, India (39th) continues to lead, advancing by one spot. The Islamic Republic of Iran (64th, down by two places) follows, with Kazakhstan (78th) in third place. Uzbekistan (83rd) retains its 4th position within the region."

India's continued rise is part of a broader innovation trend, with China, Turkey, Vietnam, and the Philippines among the fastest climbers in the last decade. Switzerland, Sweden, the US, Singapore, and the UK remain the world's top innovators.

India's Historic Triumph at the 2024 Chess Olympiad

The 2024 Chess Olympiad in **Budapest, Hungary** has etched itself into the annals of Indian sports history. In an unprecedented achievement, India secured **gold medals** in both the men's and women's team categories, marking a watershed moment for chess in the country.

Dominant Performances in the Final Round

Both Indian teams showcased their prowess in the decisive final round:

- Men's Team: Achieved a commanding 3.5-0.5 victory over Slovenia
- Women's Team: Mirrored the men's success with a 3.5-0.5 win against Azerbaijan

This dual triumph places India in an elite group, joining only **China** and the former **Soviet Union** as nations to have won gold in both categories in a single Olympiad edition.

The performance of these young stars underscores India's bright future in chess.


Women's Team: Making History
